

Arts@Trinity – Exhibitions

Arts@Trinity are happy to host exhibitions in the Holy Trinity Church. We are interested in getting in contact with up and coming artists who are keen to hold their own, two or more day exhibitions within our space.

The Brief

Exhibition events will take place over at least two days. This timeframe usually includes the installation process, although there is an option of de-installing the day after closing.

All installations will be overseen by a member of Trinity staff. He or she will have final say over how the exhibition is to be conducted.

On Tuesdays and Fridays between 12pm and 2pm the church is open for prayer time and a Eucharist service. We would ask that both exhibitors and visitors respect this. Please be aware that the installation and de-installation process would need to fit around these events.

To this end:

Exhibits must be positioned next to the outer walls in both the north and the south aisles. These can be hung from our panelled screens. No fixtures may be made to the pillars and walls.

Exhibits may be positioned in the window spaces and hung between the pillars.

Other areas may be used (e.g. Chancel, Sanctuary, Nave) providing the exhibits can be moved when necessary by A@T staff.

Invigilation is the responsibility of the exhibitors.

The exhibition will include a private viewing on one of the evenings at which A@T will run a bar.

Arts@Trinity can provide film screens and a projector, tables and chairs; other equipment, such as lighting, by negotiation.

Arts@Trinity and Holy Trinity Church accept no responsibility for the loss or damage of any artwork whilst installed in the premises. All exhibitors are encouraged to take out their own insurance against damage, loss or public liability.

The hire charge for the space needs to be negotiated with Arts@Trinity depending on the size of the exhibition, expected audience numbers and the possibility of charity rates. Arts@Trinity also take a 10% commission on any artworks or merchandise sold on their premises.
