Arts@Trinity (A@T) warmly welcomes groups, artists, musicians, exhibitors and performers in general to use the premises for the purpose of performing or exhibiting in front of public audiences.

Health and safety is of the utmost importance and users of Holy Trinity Church are required to read and abide by the Risk Management Schedule provided by A@T. They are also required to obey any instruction given by an officer of A@T in the interests of public safety and safety of the premises.

A@T has appropriate insurance which covers the premises and officers/volunteers who work on behalf of A@T, and appropriate public liability insurance which covers incidents arising out of the actions of its officers and volunteers.

A@T insurance does not cover damages, loss, claims, costs and expenses which might become legally liable as a result of bodily injury to persons or damage to material property arising out of any negligent act or omission of any person using the church for performance or exhibition or any other purpose. Users of the building are strongly encouraged to have their own insurance, including £10m public liability cover.

In addition, all electrical equipment must be safe to use in a public area and it is required that it is PAT tested. Officers of A@T have the responsibility to refuse the use of any equipment that is deemed unsafe even if PAT tested.
